This is the last will and testament
of me Isabella Gillett of Blackbrook Mill
in the township of Belper in the parish of
Duffield in the county of Derby Spinster
made this nineteenth day of May in the
year of our Lords One thousand eight hundred
and forty three. First I will and direct
that all my just debts funeral and testamentary
expences and the expences of proving this my
will be fully paid and discharged by my
executor and executor hereinafter named as soon
as conveniently may be after my decease out
of my personal estate and effects and subject
thereto I give devise and bequeath All
that my third part or share or other my part
share or interest parts shares or interests of
and in all that freeholds and copyholds
messuage dwellinghouse or tenement with the
outbuildings barns stables piggeries gardens and
appurtenances thereto belonging situate standing
and being at Blackbrook aforesaid and in
which I and my brother and sister now reside
Also of and in all that water corn-mill
situate near to the said messuage called
Blackbrook Mill being copyholds of the manor
of Belper with the mill dam water-wheels
stones machinery and all other the appurtenances
belonging or appertaining to the said mill and
now used & occupied by my brother John Gillett
Also of and in all those two closes pieces or
parcels of lands adjoining or lying near to the
said messuage and mill called the Mill Close
and Brick-kiln Close part freehold and part
copyhold containing by estimation nine acres and

sixteen perches or thereabouts be the same more or
3 less and now also in the possession of my said
brother. And also all other my messuages or
dwellinghouses or tenements closes pieces or parcels of
land hereditaments and real estate and parts
and shares thereof whatsoever and wheresoever the
same may be situate standing lying or being with
the appurtenances. And also all my household
goods and furniture plate linen china beds
bedding ready money and securities for money
and all other my personal estate and effects
whosoever and wheresoever and of which I shall
4 die possessed interested in or entitled to unto
my said brother John Gillett and my sister
Elizabeth Gillett and their respective assigns for
and during the terms of their joint natural lives
and the life of the survivor of them and from
and after their deaths and the decease of the
survivor of them then I give devise and bequeath
All and singular the same hereditaments and
premises and personal estate hereinbefore described
and mentioned unto and equally between and
amongst all and every the child and children
5 of my sister Phoebe Gutton the wife of Richard
Gutton of Radford Grove near Nottingham printer
and bookseller in equal shares and proportions
and to their several and respective heirs
executors administrators and assigns for ever
to take as tenants in common and not as joint
tenants. And lastly I do hereby nominate
constitute and appoint my said brother John
Gillett and sister Elizabeth Gillett joint executor

and executrix of this my last will and testament
herely revoking and making void all former
and other wills and testaments by me at any time
heretofore made and do declare this only to
be my last will and testament. In witness
whereof I the said testatrix Isabella Gillett
have hereunto set my hands and seal the day
and year first hereinbefore written.
