This is the last Will of Hannah Jeffery of Tolston
Widow. As soon as convenient, after my death my Executors
herein after named shall sell and dispose of my House
Garden with their appurtenances and the Money arising
therefrom to be disposed of in the following manner of my
daughter Hannah Bull quite my ^{part} ^{share} immediately
with her Family when requested by my Executors then she
shall have ten pounds more than a sixth part of the
money arising from the sale of my property but if she and her
family does not go away when requested then she shall not
receive the aforesaid Ten pounds, as respecting my Household goods
I give to my son George Jeffery my Clock and to my son John
Jeffery I give my feather Bed with all the furniture belonging
to it; all the rest of my Household furniture shall be sold and
the money arising therefrom shall go towards paying my debts
Funeral expenses &c. I give devise and bequeath to my Executor
herein after named my House Garden and Orchard with all
their appurtenances in trust to sell or dispose of to the best
advantage and the Money arising therefrom after my debts are
paid, and after Hannah Bulls ten pounds is paid the
remainder to be divided into six equal parts viz. to my son
George one sixth part, to my son John one sixth part, to my daughter Hannah
one sixth part, to my ^{grand} daughter Hannah Wallace one sixth part and
to my two grandchildren Sarah Jeffery the illegitimate daughter
of Mary Wainright deceased and George the son of the said
Mary Wainright one sixth part; and to the three illegitimate
children of my late Daughter Elizabeth Jeffery viz. Thomas
Hannah and Georgiana Jeffery one sixth part

Lastly, I do nominate constitute and appoint
William Bull of Trusley Farmer and William
Jeffery of Marston Montgomery Butcher
Executors of this my last will and Testament
hereby revoking all former Will or Wills by me
made (in Witness whereof) I have hereunto set my
hand and seal the twentysecond Day of
February one thousand eight hundred and
thirty three
