 made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of his Highnes Court at
 Richfield — at or before the first — day of May — next
 ensuing And the same goods chattels and redite and all other the goods chattels redite
 of the said deceased at the time of his death which at any time after shall come to the
 hands or possession of the said Mary Bomer — or into the hands or
 possession of any other person or persons for her do well and truly Administer
 according to law or further do make or cause to be made a true and Just account
 of her sd Accon at or before the 25th day of April in Anno Dni 1696
 and all the rest and residue of the said goods chattels and redite w^{ch} shall be found
 remaining upon the said Administratoe account the same being first examined and
 allowed of by the Judge or Judge for the time being of the said Court shall deliver
 and pay unto such person or persons respectively as the said Judge or Judge by his
 or their order or sentence pursuant to the true intent and meaning of a late Act of
 Parliament made in the two and twentieth and third and twentieth years of y reign
 of our late Sovereign Lord King Charles the second Intituled and Act for better
 settling of Intestate Estates) shall limit and appoint And if it shall hereafter
 appear that any last will and Testament was made by the said deceased and the
 Executor or Exorutor therein named do exhibit the same into the said Court making
 request to have it allowed and approved accordingly if the said Mary Bomer
 above bounden being thereunto required do render and deliver the sd Accon
 (approbation of such Testament being first had and made) in the said Court Then this
 Obligation to be void and of now effect or else to remain in full force and vertue
