This is the last Will and Testament
of me William Osbiston of Black-Brook in the
parish of Duffield and county of Derby. Wheel-
wright viz

I give devise and bequeath to my well
beloved Wife Sarah Osbiston and her Assigns
for and during the term of her natural life
the whole of my estate and effects both real and
personal of what nature or kind soever or where
soever situated the same to be applied at her
discretion towards the maintenance and support
of my children

The residue and remainder of my
estate and effects which may be left at the time
of my Wife's decease I direct to be equally shared
and divided amongst my children and in case
any of my children should die without having
received such share or shares I direct such
share or shares to be equally divided amongst
the children of such so dying or in case they
die without lawful issue I then direct such
share or shares to be equally divided amongst
my surviving children as Tenants in common
and not as joint tenants

And I do hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my brother John Osbiston of Cow-
House-Lane in the parish aforesaid Wheelwright
Sole Executor of this my Will and Testament

In Witness whereof I have hereto
set my hand and seal this tenth day of
December in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and twenty-two.
