In the Name of God Amen I John Slater of Bolsoe in the parish of Suffield and County of Derby Yeoman do Constitute ordaine and make this my last will and testament in manner & form following first I Commit my Soule to my Lord Creator hoping through the merits of Iesus Christ my Saviour to obtaine Salvation, and my body to the Earth to be buried in Christian burial at the discretion of my Executor herein after named And for my worldly Estate my Debts Legacies & funeral Expenses being first paid and discharged I do hereby will & devise give & bequeath the same as followeth Item I give to my Son Thomas Slater one Shilling Item I give to my Son Joshua Slater one Shilling Item I give & bequeath all those two dwelling houses orchards gardens & fold yard lying & being within Tuenditch in the County aforesaid with all ways waters easements Commons Commodities & appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging unto my Grandson Thomas Slater of Tuenditch and to his heirs & assigns for ever Likewise I give & bequeath unto my said Grandson Thomas Slater aforesaid Two Stockin frames and all the household goods that is in the said houses at Tuenditch aforesaid & one Chest now standing at my son John Slaters Item I Give & bequeath all those three dwelling ^{houses} out houses orchards gardens & fold yard with all ways waters Easments Commons Commodities & appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging lying & being in Suffield aforesaid unto my granddaughter Anne Parker Spingtor & to her heirs & assigns for ever Likewise I Give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter Anne Parker aforesaid & to her heirs & assigns for ever the full and just sum Ten pound of good & Lawfull money of Great Brittain to be paid by my Executor Likewise I give her one bed & bedding belonging to the same one Coffee Two Boxes & all the Linnen within them four pewter Dishes one Brass pot one brass kettle Item I give & bequeath all the rest & residue of my Estate both real and personal with all my Bills Bonds and Book debts all my Chatties & cattie ~~whatsoever~~ whatsoever which is not before disposed of unto my son John Slater of Bolsoe whom I do hereby nominate & appoint sole Executor of this my Last will & Testament revoking all former wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this thirteenth day of January in the tenth year of the Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord George the second by the grace of God King of great Brittain France and Ireland Defender of the faith In the year of our Lord 1737
