In The name of God amen, I George
Atton of Turnditch in the parish of Duffield
in the county of Derby Farmer, being weak
in body but of sound and disposing memory and
understanding, do hereby make and ordain this
my last will and Testament, in manner and
form following; that is to say...

I Order that all my just debts and funeral
expences, and all charges of proving this my
will, be in the first place fully paid and
satisfied, and after payment thereof and of every
part thereof, I give devise and bequeath
unto my beloved Wife all, every, and singular
my personal estate, money, receipts, deposits,
notes, debts, goods, chattels, cattle and farming
implements, whatsoever and wheresoever
situate at Turnditch or elsewhere in the county
of Derby for and during the term of her
natural life or marriage which shall first
happen, and from and after her death or
marriage which shall first happen I give
devise and bequeath the same unto my
three daughters, Hannah, Sarah, and Mary
Atton share and share alike, unless any one
of my said daughters shall marry Samuel
Butler son of James and Hannah Butler
late of Hble in the County of Derby, then in
that case I will that the said share of her so
marrying the said Samuel Butler, shall be
equally divided between my other two daughters

share and share alike the daughter so marrying
to receive the sum of one Shilling of current
coin of the Realm of Great Britain.

3 ALSO I give devise and bequeath all my
Real Estate whatsoever and wheresoever. Lands
Tenements, with the Tithes thereon, and all
other Tithes, Hereditaments, Rents, Issues,
and profits arising therefrom, with the
appurtenances thereto belonging situate and
lying at Linder Lane or Lindway Lane in
the Parish of Crick in the County of Derby
or elsewhere unto my beloved Wife Hannah
Alton for and during the term of her natural
life or Marriage which shall first happen and
from and after her death or Marriage which
shall first happen. I give devise and bequeath
the same unto my three daughters Hannah
Sarah, and Mary Alton and their Heirs for ever
4 share and share alike with power to sell, buy
or Mortgage from one to the other of the said
parties only as joint Tenants and not as Tenants
common, Nevertheless if any one of my said
daughters shall marry the said Samuel Butler
herein by me before named. I will that all and
every her share in my real Estate be equally
divided between my other two daughters and
their Heirs for ever share and share alike

AND lastly I do hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my good friend Mr Charles
5 Allsop of Postern in the parish of Duffield
in the county of Derby, Gent^l my beloved
Wife Hannah Alton, my three daughters

Hannah, Sarah, and Mary Alton, (the one who may marry Samuel Butler to be excluded) joint Executors and Executrices of this my Will hereby revoking all former will or wills by me heretofore made and declare this only to be my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I the said Testator have to this my last Will and Testament, set my hand and seal this twenty third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Forty seven (1847)
