During her natural Life While she keeps in the same
name and then I bequeth all my Effects after her Decease
unto my three Sons. Sam^l James and John. equil share and
Share alike their executors administrators and Assigns only
paying to my four Daughters Hannah Sarah Elizabeth and
Ann. the Sum of five pounds each and to my Daughter
Mary the Sum of twenty pounds to be paid twelve months
after my wife Decease I nominate and constitute and appoint
My wife Mary and my Son James Joint Executors of my
last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand and seald this seventeenth Day of Novem-
ber in the Year of our Lord. one thousand seven hundred
and Ninety nine.
