 make this my Last Will and Testamon: In manner and forme
 following first I comitt my Soule to Iesus Christ my Saviour
 Hoping through his merits to obtaine Salvation and my body
 to the Earth from whence it was taken to be Buried in Christian
 Burial at the Discretion of my Exceutrix herein after Named
 and for my worldly Estate my Debts Legacies and Funerall
 Expences being first paid and Discharged Doo hereby Will Devise
 Give and Bequeath the same as followeth: Imprimis first
 of all I do Will and Devise and Bequeath one peice of Land
 Lying in Bohort Liberty In parish & Countie aforesd: Lying by
 Sarsons side Commonly Calld by Round: mowen with all comminges
 Commodities and profites having it now in my owne possession to the
 use and behoofe of Sarah my Loving Wife for terms of her
 naturall life And provided That she shall pay these Thre
 Legacies following first that is to say To David Slatter Son of
 my Brother Josiah Slater of Suffield in Countie aforesd: the said
 Sum of Ten pounds of Lawfull monies of Great Brittain within
 the space of a year next after my Decease Item that is to say
 Ten pounds of Lawfull monies of Great Brittain to be paid by her
 unto Thomas Slatter of turndich in parish and Countie aforesd:
 within the space of a year next after my Decease Item that is to
 say Ten pounds more to be paid by her within the space of a year
 next after my Decease to and behoofe of her sley in Countie aforesd:
 my Cozon the Daughter of John porter of horsley But provided that she
 shall prove to be with Child Lawfully Begotten by me It is to Remaine
 Cleare to her and her heires for Ever But If not then it is to go as
 before mentioned and after her Decease to go to my Cozon Daniel Slater
 the said Sunn of Josiah Slater aforesd: to him and to his Right heires
 for Ever and Lastly I do Will Devise give and Bequeath all my good
 quere and Dead and all my personall Estate whatsoever unto Sarah
 my Loving wife her heires Executors Administrators and assigns for Ever
 whom I do nominate and appoint Exceutor of this my Last will and
 testament and Revoking all former wills made by me I do constitute ordaine
 this to be my Last will and testam: In witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & seall this 27th day of July in the Ninth year of the Reigne
 of our Lord George King of Great Brittain France and Ireland: Defender of
