House and Barns Shop and gardens and Two Pieces or parcels of Land Called the
upper and neather Croft Lying In Belper Late Mr Heaths and now in the
Possession of John Milward With all ways Waters easments Comans and
Appurtanances There unto Belonging During the Term of His Natural Life
And from and after His Deceas unto His Son William Slater To him and
His Heirs for Ever Also I give and Bequeath unto my Son Thomas Slater
Sixty Pounds
Also I give and Bequeath and Devise unto my Son Joseph Slater Two coppes hold
Closes Lying By the Choven Side in Belper aforesaid Called Three Nobbs Piece
And Trades Close Now in my Possession With all Ways Waters Comans and
Appurtanances There unto Belonging To Him his Heirs and Assigns for
Ever
Also I give Devise and Bequeath To my Son Antoney Slater one Piece of
Land in Belper Lying and joining To Richard Tomlinsons Late Mr Heaths
But Later in the Possession of the fore said John Milward Likewise
one other Piece in Belper field Late Bradleys and Now in the Possession

and To Have It Copt Winter and Summer and one House To dwell in
standing on My free Houls Estate upon the Intacks on Cheven Ward
and Ten Pounds a year During the Term of Her Natural Life and These
Legeses and Soms of Money To be paid By My Executor here in After
Named as They com Sevrally at Twenty one years of age and To pay there
Till Then Interest at four Percent Per annum for one Hundred Pound yearly
and Every year
Also I give Devise and Bequeath To my Son William Slater All my
Freehouls houses and Land lying upon the Intacks on Cheven Ward with
one other Piece of Land lying In Parond Medoore there (aled Bradshaw
Close all in my own Possession with all Ways Waters Easment
Commons and appurthances there To Belonging Also all my Personal
Estate both quick and Dead with all Marriages Bills Bonds and Book Depts
Tobin and his heirs and Assigns for Ever
Also I give and Bequeath To My Nephew William Slater the Son of Thomas
Slater five Pound Also I give and Bequeath To My Nephew John Devil
the Son of Slater Devil the Son of five Pound Also I give and Bequeath
To my Niece Sarah Devil the Daughter of Father Devil the Son of five
Pound These Legeses To be paid By My Son William Slater Whom I
Nominate and Appoint Sole Executor and Executor of This my Last Will
And Testament By me made In Witness Where of I have here unto

Hundred and eighty Two
