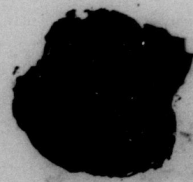
In the Name of God Amen I Daniel Walker the Elder of Middleton in the parish of Wirksworth in the County of Derby Miners being of sound and disposing mind Memory and understanding praise be given to almighty God for the same do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following First I will and direct that all my just debts funeral expences and the expences of touching and proving this my last Will and Testament shall be fully paid and discharged by my Executor hereinafter named as soon as conveniently may be after my decease And I give and Devise unto my Son Joseph Walker and his Heirs and assigns for ever all that piece or parcel of Land called or known by the name of Piegreaves or long load single the same lying and being in Middleton aforesaid with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging And lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint my said Son Joseph Walker sole Executor of this my last Will hereby revoking and making void all former Will or Wills by me made I publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I Daniel Walker the Elder the Testator have hereunto set and put my hand and Seal this thirty first day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixteen.
